Class times: Morning class meets from 8:25-10:45. Drop off at red doors between 8:20 and 8:25 AM and pick up at red doors at 10:45 AM. Afternoon class meets from 12:25-2:45 PM. Drop off at red doors between 12:20 and 12:25 AM. Pick up at red doors at 2:45 PM.

Paperwork: All parents - please fill out and submit the four required forms on the Woodford County Special Education Association website (wcsea.us). New students only - You will bring a courthouse copy of your child's birth certificate, recent physical with immunization record, and proof of income to the required orientation appointment.

Transportation: Special transportation is provided for special education students who require transportation in order to receive services. The MGS transportation department will call you in late July or early August regarding routes/times. **There are no transportation services for the PreK (non IEP)** students. There has been limited transportation in the past. However, due to safety concerns and limited bus space, this service is no longer available.

Book bags: Children need to bring their book bag to school every day. I will place papers and notes home in the bag so please check it daily.
