Welcome! I am Natalie Wood and I will be your child's teacher for the 26-27 school year. I have been a teacher for 15 years teaching kindergarten, first grade, and now preschool! I am thrilled to have your child in my classroom at Metamora Grade. Working alongside me as our program paraprofessional is DAndra Derr. DAndra has been part of WCSEA for many years now and we are so excited that she is back at Metamora Grade School for the 26-27 school year!

Meet the Teacher:

NEW Students: are required to attend the Drop off paperwork/supplies, meet the teacher, and see the classroom on August 17th anytime between 4:00-5:30pm.

New students must bring:

- ★ the courthouse copy of the birth certificate,
- ★ physical with immunization records,
- ★ and the income verification. (if both parents are working, income verification is needed from both parents). Items accepted include: W2 form, 2 consecutive pay stubs, proof of WIC benefits, proof of SNAP benefits, parent's medicaid card, recent tax return.

All families will receive a calendar and handout about classroom procedures.

Please remember that all paperwork must be received and all parents must attend the Back to School event in order for your child to start school. Contact me if you need an alternative appointment.

Morning class session meets from **8:15-10:45**. Drop off at red doors at **8:10** and pick up at red doors at **10:45 AM**. The afternoon class meets from **12:15-2:45 PM**. Drop off at red doors **12:10** and pick up at red doors at **2:45 PM**. Please read the reminders and procedures form about how we do drop off and pick up. It is super important for student safety. Thanks!

Transportation: Special transportation is provided for special education students who require transportation in order to receive services.
