Welcome! I am Mrs. Teresa Fandel, your child's teacher. I am so pleased to work with you and your child this year!

**Required Meet the Teacher August 16th:** Drop in anytime between 1:00-2:30PM and bring school supplies. New families bring the birth certificate, physical with immunization record, and proof of income. An orientation slideshow link will be provided to new families. All families will receive a calendar and handout for classroom procedures.

**Start date:** August 18th. Our class is located at Metamora Grade School.

**Class times -** Morning Class meets 8:20-10:50 am. Afternoon class meets 12:20-2:50 pm.

**Paperwork-** Please fill out the four required forms on the wcsea website (wcsea.us). Click on Bright Beginnings Preschool Registration link. New students only - You will bring a courthouse copy of your child's birth certificate, recent physical with immunization record, and proof of income to the Meet the Teacher day.

**Bus-** Bussing service may or may not be available for your child. Please refer to the MGS transportation document on the wcsea website registration page.

**Book bags-** Children need to bring their book bag (on supply list) and folder on a daily basis. I ask that any notes or correspondence from you be placed in your child's folder (on the supply list). The folder will be checked for messages and I will place school notes in the folder to go home.

**About the Classroom-** I team with Mrs. Phelps and Mrs. Derr, classroom teacher assistants. We have a lot of new and exciting things planned. One of our classroom highlights is our integration of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) activities to promote thinking and problem solving skills. We also have an outstanding exercise program we do every day to build up core strength and endurance. Mrs. Phelps loves to read books to the children and engage them in questions after the stories. Our goals for the year include building social skills, strengthening fine motor skills, becoming independent, and respecting others. We will see you very soon!
