ENROLLMENT LETTER

Welcome! I am Mrs. Messer, your child's teacher! Mrs. Hoffer and I are pleased to work with you this year.

Paperwork- Please fill out the four required forms on the wcsea website (wcsea.us). Click on the Bright Beginnings Preschool Registration link. **New students only - You will drop off the courthouse copy of your child's birth certificate, recent physical with immunization record at Riverview Grade School anytime before August 6th.**

Meet the Teacher- Required Meet the Teacher is on **August 12th**. Come anytime between 3:00-5:00PM on the school playground. Please park in the back of the school. We will be set up by the cones. Please bring school supplies with you.

First day of class: August 18th

Class times - Morning class meets 8:10-10:40AM and Afternoon meets 12:30-3:00PM

Bus- Morning - There is no bus service to school but a bus will take your child home after class. Please wait in the front of the building at 8:10 am when dropping your child off. We enter/exit from the main doors. We walk students to the bus after class. Afternoon - a bus will pick up your child and bring them to school. Parents pick up after school.

Book bags- Children need to bring their book bag and folder on a daily basis. I ask that any notes or correspondence from you be placed in your child's folder (folder will be provided with a calendar). The folder will be checked for messages and I will place school notes in the folder to go home.

Class Website - Our class website is Riverview Bright Beginnings (<https://sites.google.com/wcsea.us/mrs-messers-class/home>). I will also email a Seesaw (class social media site) registration to new families. Please download the apps (both student and family). You then scan the code that I send you to log your child in. It should work on any tablet, computer or phone. Please let me know if you have any trouble.

About the Classroom- Mrs. Hoffer (teacher assistant) and I look forward to another new school year with lots of new and exciting things planned. One of our classroom highlights is the integration of science and nature activities to promote thinking, awareness of responsibility, and appreciation of nature.
