Meet the Teacher:

All Returning Students: Supply Dropoff - Tuesday, August 11th, 2pm-3pm
(returning students unavailable this day can bring supplies on the first day of school).

All NEW students: Attend the REQUIRED Meet the Teacher Open House on August 11th, 3:30pm-4:30pm.

New families must bring to meet the teacher:

- ★ the courthouse copy of the birth certificate,
- ★ physical with immunization record, and
- ★ the proof of income (if both parents are working, income verification is needed from both parents). Items accepted include: **W2 form, 2 consecutive pay stubs, proof of WIC benefits, proof of SNAP benefits, parent's medicaid card, recent tax return.**

Please remember that all paperwork must be received and all new parents must attend the Back to School event in order for your child to start school.

First day of class: Wednesday, August 12th

Class times: The morning class meets 8:10-10:40am and the afternoon meets 12:25-2:55pm.
